He collapsed suddenly while preaching  
at the 15th Arnhem commemoration service  
at the Military Stadium, Aldershot.

Quotation from the Farnham Herald Sept 20 1963

" In his sermon Bishop Johnston was talkin of his  
war experiences in Egypt and how the sappers  
had lit up the Cathedral and how the beam of  
searchlight had made a great V in the centeer  
of which stood the cross on top of Cairo  
Cathedrl. " That is the real Victory, the Victory  
of the Cross," he said, and collapsed.

The next hymn on the service order sheet was

" For all the Saints who from their labours  
rest."
