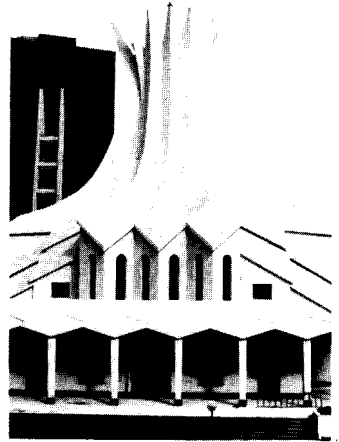

Panita is working towards her GCSE's next year at Wadhurst.

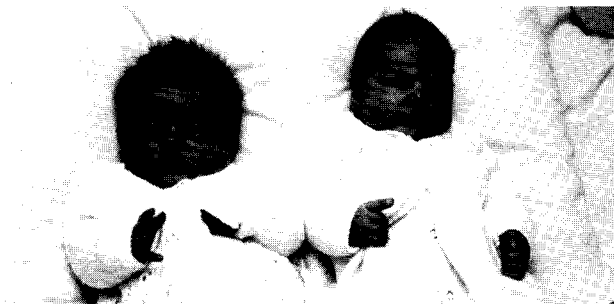
