I. AIMS :

1. To encourage regularity in private prayer, public worship, and attendance at the Holy Communion among Church members in the Hospital.
2. To help towards a deeper understanding of the Christian Faith and the building up of our life in Christ, by provision of a Service of Preparation for Holy Communion to take place at least once a month.
3. To encourage the Church's Ministry of Healing through Prayer and the Sacraments.

II. OBLIGATIONS :

1. Members pledge themselves to support and further the aims of the Guild, believing it to be an instrument for the building up of our life in Christ, and for extending His influence and His power in the Hospital.
2. They will be required to attend Divine Service on Sunday and to receive Holy Communion regularly, preferably once a week.
3. Members will pledge themselves to be present at the monthly Corporate Communion of the Guild and to attend the Services of Preparation, unless hindered by duty.
4. They will undertake to pray and read the Bible daily, and make for themselves some rule of life however simple. A helpful scheme is suggested by the Guild.

**N.B.—**Membership of the Guild lapses for any Member who fails to attend three consecutive monthly meetings of the Guild without previous notification to the Secretary or the Chaplain.
